All contracts and rosters must be submitted to Site Director at first game. Player contracts will be released upon payment of franchise fees. Complete all forms and return with payment to: Division of Youth and Adult Sports (BNBL), Upton Boxing Center, 1901 Pennsylvania Ave, Baltimore, MD 21217 before **May 4, 2018**.

Franchise Fee (Non-refundable): **\$200 PER TEAM** Youth Division (Male/Female), **MONEY ORDERS ONLY AND PAYABLE TO "DIRECTOR OF FINANCE"**; Fee must accompany the application registration.

BACKGROUND CHECKS: Background checks are **mandatory** for all coaches, managers, and coordinators who participate in the Baltimore City Department of Recreation and Parks Coaches Certification Program. **Background checks can be scheduled by appointment and completed at 3001 East Drive (Druid Hill Park) Monday-Friday 9 a.m. - 4 p.m. (410) 396-7605.**

I.D. INFORMATION: All players must have one of the following ID cards that displays a photo and date of birth: **Learners Permit, Maryland Driver's License/State ID Card, Age of Majority Card.**

REFEREES: Officials are paid on the floor by teams **PRIOR** to the start of the game. Fee is \$27 per game/per team.

SPECIAL NO PRESS RULE: For ages 7 & under boys and 7 & 9 under girls - 1) The defensive team cannot press or play person-to-person until the ball has passed the DIVISION LINE; 2) Penalties - First violation-team warning, Second violation- 2 free throws plus ball for division line throw-in; 3) Defensive team will be allowed to press or play person to person during the last 2 minutes of the fourth quarter and all overtime.
